WATER HEATERS, WATER TREATMENTS, SANITIZING WATER CONTAINERS

This month I have attached 2 documents for your review. If there is an emergency you will need to know how to access the water in your water heater safely. Your water heater will give you access to approximately 40-80 gallons of water and <u>after being treated</u> will provide you with water for drinking as well as cleaning. The first document will provide you with the instructions you need to accomplish this task. Download, print and save till needed.

The other document explains the different ways you can treat water to make it safe to drink. It also explains which water is safe to treat and which water is not. Once you've treated your water you will need to store it in some type of container that has been sanitized. This document will also give instructions on how to sanitize your containers. Again, I would download, print and save to have in case of an emergency. Remember, you may not have access to a computer during an emergency.
